During these next days, we ask for your continued prayers for the 46 orphans you are sponsoring through Mission:Chad. The \$30 per child a month and others you are giving to are not just God's blessing but also the opportunities through Mission:Chad to impact the whole nation and various communities including orphans, indigenous missionaries, students and professors of the Bible School in Chad.

We are bound to one another as believers and in the various ways we have been challenged by each other. The orphans of Chad need shelters and we trust God that He will provide to supply for them this need. We have a portion of land in Moundou located in the South of Chad and started to fire 30,000 bricks on it. By God willing we will begin to build some modest homes. The SCPEDT will need a couple expatriate missionary from Mission:Chad to manage and supervise the project from the beginning of January 2006.

It is in this spirit that we write to encourage you in your involvement with SCPEDT and Mission:Chad to claim the Promise of Jeremiah 29:11, that God has a plan for us. Would you faithful men and women of God stand with us in prayer in this project? Maybe God is calling you to join us already.
