Meet the Children of Mission:Chad

A widow came to me recently with tears in her eyes and said, "Please, pastor I have many fatherless children. Their father was a committed Christian, even an elder in the Church as well as policeman but he died four years ago. I have nothing to do with all these children, please pastor just take at least one or two of them in your organization (SCPEDT) which can find Christian sponsors who may pray for them and support them.

This widow is old and almost blind. Pray that just as Jesus said, whoever receives one of these children in His Name, receives Him and God (Mark 9:37).

A relative of one of the orphans we are sponsoring through Mission:Chad came to me at night and said, " Pastor, you don't know me but I came to thank you for what your organization is doing for my orphan cousin. Nobody in the family was able to help her but since she was sponsored three years ago, things became better in her life." I told her, " This is God's work for the destitute children and those without voice in the world, please thank God for that." I think, some extended families begin to see the transformation in the lives of these hopeless children and are thankful for what God is doing through our partners in USA.

As we remember this, let us keep praying that God will provide more funds to register other orphans. The forty orphans that SCPEDT is taking care of are just a tip of an iceberg in Chad.
