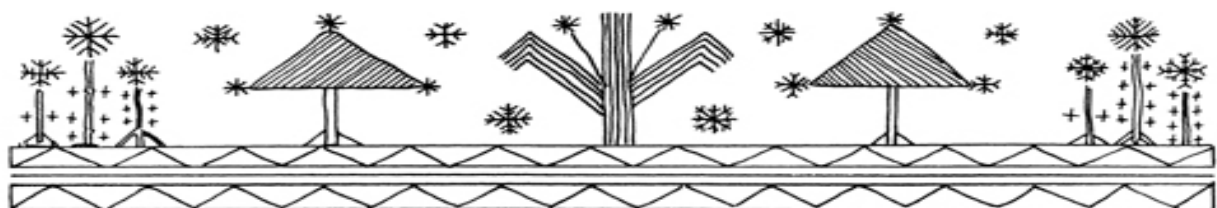
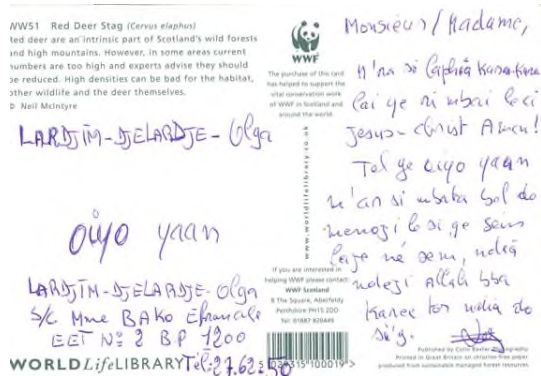
**From the Evangelical High School of Poudoumoan
