The logo of the "Bowl of Life" was selected after many months of careful thought as to how the people of Chad and the mission of Mission:Chad could best be expressed through art. You will see that our new logo contains an African "bol", or bowl, which bears the sign of the cross.

This symbol was selected to signify the fact that most families in Chad eat only once a day. It is a simple meal of millet, ground, cooked, and served in a bowl made from a gourde. This "bowl" thus comes to symbolize that which sustains life in a very difficult place. Our logo comes from the design on such a bowl. bears the sign of the cross to remind us that Christ is the one who ultimately sustains our lives.
